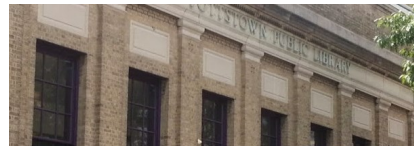


## Something Amazing is Happening at Your Library
